# English - Reading Class Reader—The BFG

- Using this text, children:
- Participate in discussion about both books that are read to them and those that they read for themselves, taking turns and listening to what others say
- ♦ Check that the text makes sense to them, discussing their understanding and explaining the meaning of words in context
- ♦ Ask questions to improve their understanding of the text

## **English - Writing**

- Using texts, videos, sound clips, news reports and drama children create their own:
- ♦ Fictional writing—myths, fairy tales and traditional tales
- ♦ Non-fictional writing—diaries, scientific reports, instructions
  - ♦ Rhyming poetry
- Children develop their technical skills by using:
  - ♦ Commas to separate items in a list
    - ♦ Apostrophes for contractions
  - ♦ Coordinating and subordinating conjunctions

## **Computing**

- Using a range of software packages, the children:
  - Design algorithms with statements and loops
    - ♦ Run simulations of physical systems
- ♦ Collect various data and present as a branching database.
- ♦ Explore the effect of changing variables in algorithms

## **Art and Design**

- Collage 'Mythical Creatures'- Using a range of techniques, children will:
  - ♦ Refine collaging skills
  - ♦ Explore the appropriateness of various materials
- Sculpture and painting 'Greek Pots' Using a design brief and their own research, the children:
- ♦ Use clay and other malleable materials and practise joining techniques
- Cut, make and combine shapes to create recognisable forms

#### **Mathematics**

- Children study a range of topics:
- Place value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, Division, Statistics and Measurement
- Within these, children:
  - ♦ Use the inverse operation to check accuracy
  - Consistently use the formal written methods to solve 2-step problems
    - ♦ Interpret discrete and continuous data
    - $\diamond$  Begin to recall all multiplication and division facts up to 12x12
      - ♦ Convert between different units of measure

## **History: Ancient Greece**

      - Source check data for reliability

# French (MFL)

Learn to hold a simple conversation with a partner

Be able to say their name, how old they are, where they live and their nationality

Learn the nouns and articles/determiners for key members of the family

#### Science

- 'Sound- Using systematic data collection in independent investigations, with a variety of recording methods, children:
  - ♦ Learn that sound is vibrations
- 'States of matter'- Using systematic data collection in independent investigations, with a variety of recording methods, children:
  - ♦ Classify matter into its 3 states
  - ♦ Observe changes due to temperature

### **Religious Education\***

- 'Buddhism'- Using religious texts, videos, books and soundbites, children:
  - Explore Buddhist virtues and beliefs
  - Explore how they influence lives around the world
- Beatitudes'- Using religious texts, videos, books and soundbites, children:
  - Consider moral decisions and their impacts on others
  - Make links between Christian beliefs and Christian lives

# **Physical Education**

- 'Football, Hockey and Netball'- using games and drills, children:
  - ♦ Get into viable positions to shoot or score
    - ♦ Dodge, mark and signal
- 'Dance'- using sequences and performances, children:
  - ♦ Remember and repeat more complex sequences

#### Music

- Wider Opportunity—Learning to play the recorder
  - Begin to read music notation
  - Playing together at a class

#### **PSHE**

- 'Identity, society and quality' and 'Drugs, alcohol and tobacco education,' children:
- Understand that Great Britain is a democracy and that laws are made to keep people safe
- Can define 'addiction' and know the risks of drinking alcohol
